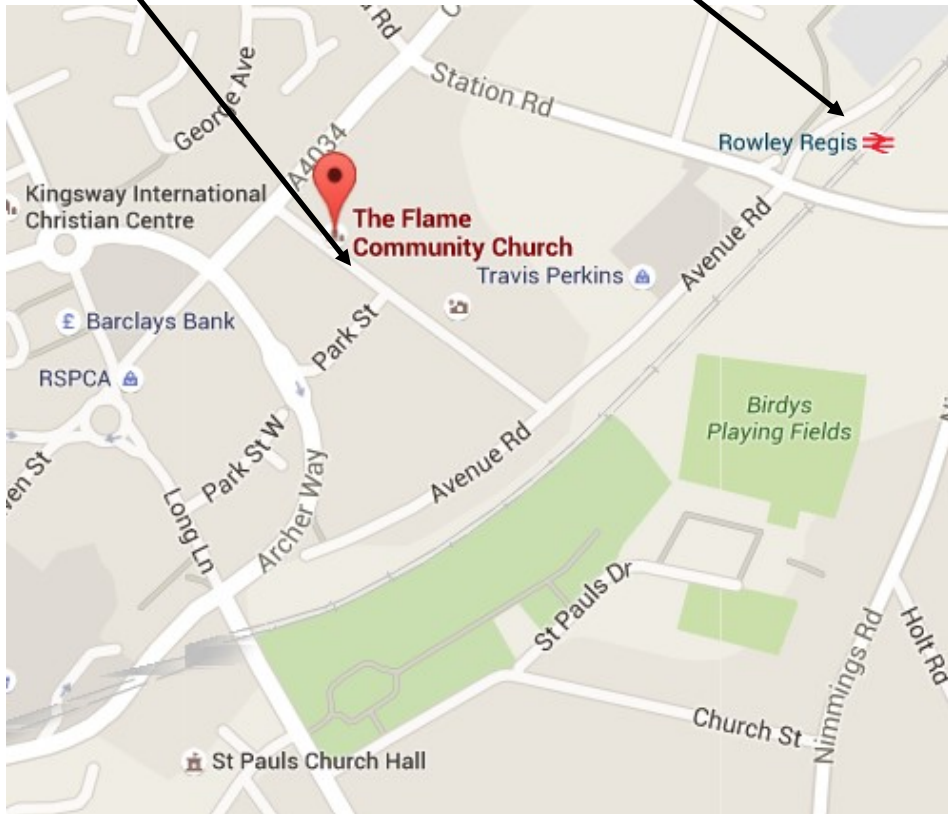


Travel: Driving: 6 miles or 16 minutes from Five Ways roundabout at the junction of Hagley Rd, Broad St & the Middle Ring Rd.

- Take the Hagley Rd (A456) going West.
- Turn right at A4123 (Wolverhampton Rd)
- Left at the lights signposted Blackheath into Pound Rd
- Left at T junction and follow the road round, over the M5, to a roundabout
- Take 2nd exit. Then just past railway line turn right into the station to park free for the day
- Then walk back and cross the road into Avenue Rd. First right is Cardale St. The Church is along on the right.
